GFWC Community Scholarship 2026

Eligibility

Applicants must:

1. Be a resident of Auburn, MA
2. Be a high school senior graduating in 2026.
3. Plan to enroll in part-time or full-time undergraduate study at an accredited two-year or four-year college, university, or vocational-technical school for the upcoming school year.
4. Have a cumulative grade average of at least 75 (1.9)
5. Have participated in a minimum of 6 activities (e.g., extracurriculars, sports, employment, volunteering) in high school. Each year of participation in a recurring activity counts separately. As an example:
 - *Freshman*: Cross Country (1)
 - *Sophomore*: Rockets to Rockets (1)
 - *Junior*: Student Council, employment at Auburn Town Pizza (2)
 - *Senior*: Yearbook, Student Council (2)

Notification

Informal candidate interviews will be held at 6:00 PM on May 18th, 2026. You will be notified in advance to attend.

Award winners will be contacted no later than **May 30, 2026**.

Payment of Award

The scholarship will be awarded after receipt of sealed, first semester college transcripts. Deadline to receive transcripts by AJWC is January 15, 2027.

Requirements

- **1 copy of your sealed high school transcript**, issued by your school's Guidance Department
- **1 copy of filled-out Application** (*Page 2*) typed or neatly printed in black ink
- **1 copy of Essay Answers** typed or neatly printed in black ink. Pages must be single-sided and double-spaced, if typed. Please **DO NOT** put your name on this page. Judges will evaluate these responses anonymously.
